## RESOLUTION 2-2017 RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A GOPHER BOUNTY WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, Minn Stat. 348.12 and 348.13 authorizes towns to offer a bounty for the destruction of gophers and ground squirrels:

WHEREAS, the town board determines gopher constitute a nuisance to property, particularly property being used for agricultural purposes;

WHEREAS, the town board determines that it is in the beast interest of the public to establish a bounty to encourage the destruction of gophers in the township;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the town board of Long Lake Township does hereby establish a gopher bounty in the township to be conducted as follows:

- The bounty shall only apply to gophers that were, to the satisfaction of the town board chair, captured and killed with the boundaries of the township.
- To be eligible for collection of the bounty on an animal, the four feet of striped of gophers and both front feet of pocket gophers must be presented to the town board chair.
- 3. The person claiming a bounty must provide the town his or her name, address and the location of where the animals were killed.
- 4. The amount of the bounty shall be \$2.00.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED,** that this resolution shall automatically renew unless amended or repealed by the town board by resolution.
