

ANNUAL MEETING  
MARCH 10, 2026

The 2026 Annual Meeting was called to order by Clerk Patsy at 7:00 p.m. Pledge of allegiance was given by those present. Present were: Tom Malloy, Pat Vanguilder, Mark Olson, David Johnson, Virginia Smart, Steve Dryburgh, Gene Baron, Kurt Schenk, Amy Bear, Tim Holmes, Ron and Judy Rardin, Gary and Gloria Hanson and Lisa Olson.

Motion by Virginia Smart to have David Johnson serve as moderator, seconded by Tom Malloy and carried.

Minutes of the 2025 annual meeting were read. Financial report was given.

Steve Dryburge gave a brief presentation for Zone One First Responders. There are 30 members serving nine townships. There were 69 calls with 8 in Long Lake Township.

The road report was given by Johnson. There was a discussion about the five-year plan for townships roads.

Johnson asked: "how many of use the township's website." Only two had.

Johnson gave a presentation about the ordinance the town is considering for new developments.

Live streaming the town meetings was discussed. There may be a grant available for this from Sourcewell.

Resurfacing Mogensen Shore: Johnson to put the estimates on the website.

Fire Chief Tim Holmes talked about the well on County Road 22. There is a possibility that another well could be driven if a grant is obtained.

Motion by Judy Rardin, seconded by Mark Olson and carried to make donations to the same organizations as last year: School Safety Camp \$275.00, CWC Historical Society \$500.00. CWC Fair Association \$1,000.00, Zone One First Responders \$1,000.00 and The Salvation Army Food Shelf \$500.00.

Motion by Virginia Smart to allow the town board to spend up to \$700.00 for miscellaneous expenses, seconded by Ron Rardin and carried.

Motion by Amy Bear to levy \$300,000.00 for Road and Bridge, \$50,000.00 for General Revenue and \$50,000.00 for the Fire Fund. The motion was seconded by Ron Rardin and carried.

Calcium Chloride was discussed. Johnson stated that the supervisor have learned about an additive that could extend the life of the spray. The roads should have a crown of 6 inches for a 20 foot wide roadbed.

Motion by Lisa Olson, seconded by Gary Hanson and carried to set the time for the 2027 annual meeting at 6:00 p.m.

Motion by Lisa Olson, seconded by Judy Rardin to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried and the meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
