

REGULAR MEETING  
February 17, 2026

The regular meeting of the Long Lake Board of Supervisors was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chair David Johnson. Present were: Supervisors Thomas Malloy and Mark Olson, Treasurer Virginia Smart, Deputy Clerk Lisa Olson and Clerk Patsy Olson. Stan Mattern was also present. The pledge of allegiance was given.

Malloy moved to accept the January minutes as presented. Motion was seconded by M. Olson and carried. Motion by Olson, seconded by Malloy to approve the treasurer's report, subject to audit. Motion was seconded by Malloy and carried.

Stan Mattern is interested in bidding for the road maintenance contract. He currently works for Crow Wing Township and part of the City of Baxter. He has 3 graders and 6 stake trucks plus other equipment. He does not have a road reclaimer. He can mulch brush and tree trimming. He gets class 5 from Sander's Construction, Randall. Current price is \$13.00 per yard delivered. He makes his own salt/sand mixture. He stated that he would like 1 and 1/2 hours' notice for snow plowing to allow him time to get his crew going. The clerk to email him the bidding notice.

Motion by Johnson, seconded by M. Olson to have Crow Wing County approach Crow Wing Power about annexing parcels 57060513 and 75060516. Motion was seconded by Olson and carried with all voting in favor.

Supervisor will meet at the town hall on Thursday, February 26 at 10:00 am for road webinar.

Road contract renewal. Clerk to send last bid notice to Johnson. Will be finalized at the April meeting. The road maintenance policy will also be discussed.

Spring short course will be held on Monday March 23 at Breezy Point.

Motion by Johnson, seconded by Malloy to approve the liquor license renewal for Dennis Drummond Wine Co. Motion carried with all voting in favor.

Sourcewell: Darwin Hanson will give Johnson an estimate to update I pads for supervisors and adding CTAS to deputy clerk's and treasurer's I pads.

M. Olson reported that there had been a large garbage dump on Oakridge Road, but the responsible party had been notified and it was cleaned up.

Brookside Plat: nothing has been received back from property owners.

Lake Ave: Nothing new.

Clerk received a email from Deb Morgan on January 26<sup>th</sup>, that the deed would be address in the next 30 days.

Subdivision ordinance: Nothing more has been done.
