

REGULAR MEETING
JULY 21, 2026

The regular meeting of the Long Lake Board of Supervisors was called to order at 5:30 by Chair David Johnson. Present were: Supervisors Thomas Malloy and Mark Olson, Treasurer Virginia Smart, Deputy Clerk Lisa Olson and Clerk Patsy Olson. Also present were: Barry Nelson, Rob Ramny, Bill Shook, Dale Spaulding, Jack Engholm, Robert Engholm, Judy Rardin, Gary Engholm and Kirsten Rude. The pledge of allegiance was given.

Motion by M. Olson, seconded by Malloy and carried to approve the minutes of the last meetings as presented. Motion by Olson, seconded by Malloy and carried to approve the treasurer's report, subject to audit.

Rob Ramny stated that brushing on Paradise Beach Road was not a good job. The brushing crew cut part of the hedge in front of his property and then left a large area undone. It looked like a mess. Olson had looked at the work and stated that it was not a good job. Holmvig had called him and stated that someone had complained about cutting and they left it undone. Johnson to contact Holmvig about finishing the work.

Barry Nelson stated that the "No trespassing signs" on Lake Ave. are confusing. Olson stated that he Had been there and the signs had been turned around. He changed them back.

Jack Engholm: they are subdivided property and wanted to know if the road had to meet township specifications. He was told that only if they want the township to take over maintenance of the road.

District meeting in Little Falls: Clerk to register for 5 to attend. M. Olson will drive starting at 4:15 p.m.

DRT meeting: Sierra Schultz is requesting change from agricultural to rural residential for 40 acre parcel into two 20 acre parcels. Johnson to notify CWC that the township has no objection to the change.

Sourcewell: The same estimate from last year for comp. plan update can be used to apply for a grant.

The locate for signs on Mogensen Shores and Weidel Point roads has been done.

Johnson to order 4 inch post pole driver for the township. Cost is \$49.90.

Johnson reported that he had talked to Rob Hall about vacating a portion of the platted street intersecting with County Road 22. There was talk about doing a land swap. Johnson

stated that he had talked to the Leichtenaur family and they would like to have the road vacated.

Kirstin Rude: she currently operates a micro school and is moving to property on Gilbert Lane. The school would be in a pole building with possibly 20 to 30 pupils. There are 3 teachers. The septic system needs to be upgraded and an additional driveway will be installed. The survey done for the plat needs to be changed to the current owners and the county would accept it.
